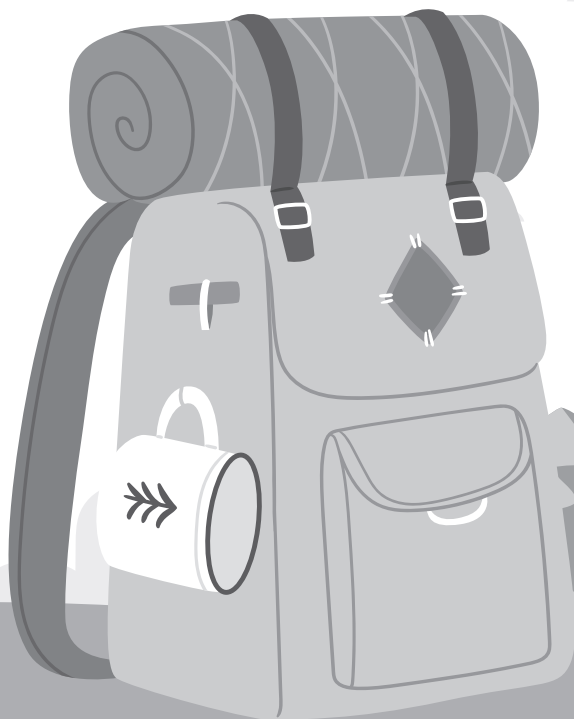

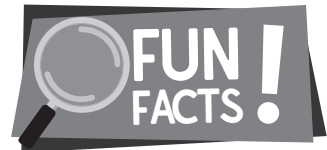

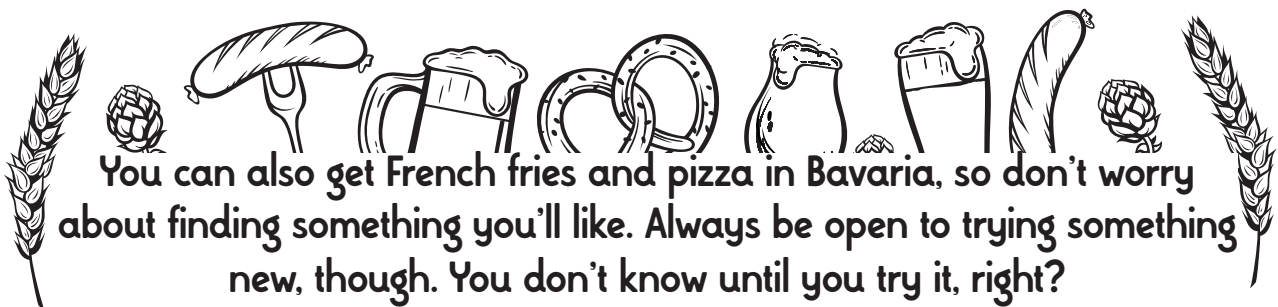
Fun Fact #1:

Hofbräu literally means court brewer. So back in the day (1828), the Munich Hofbräuhaus (court-brewer-house) made beer for royals and politicians to drink when they gathered to talk. Today, it serves lunch and dinner for everyone. Check it out!

The most popular cheeses in Germany are Gouda and Emmental. You must try both! They're delicious.



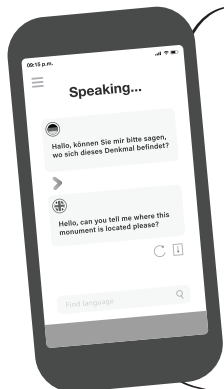
You can also get French fries and pizza in Bavaria, so don't worry about finding something you'll like. Always be open to trying something new, though. You don't know until you try it, right?

The Schnitzel is our favorite! It's a yummy dish made from different types of meat. It's covered in breadcrumbs and then fried in butter. The most popular type of meat for schnitzel is veal (Wiener Schnitzel) or pork (Schweineschnitzel). It can also be made with chicken (Hähnchenschnitzel), or turkey (Putenschnitzel), too. Try some potato salad on the side! It's perfect for both kids and grown-ups!




There are free apps out there that can translate German for you and also say the German word or phrase for you so you can pronounce it. Load the app to your phone before you travel!

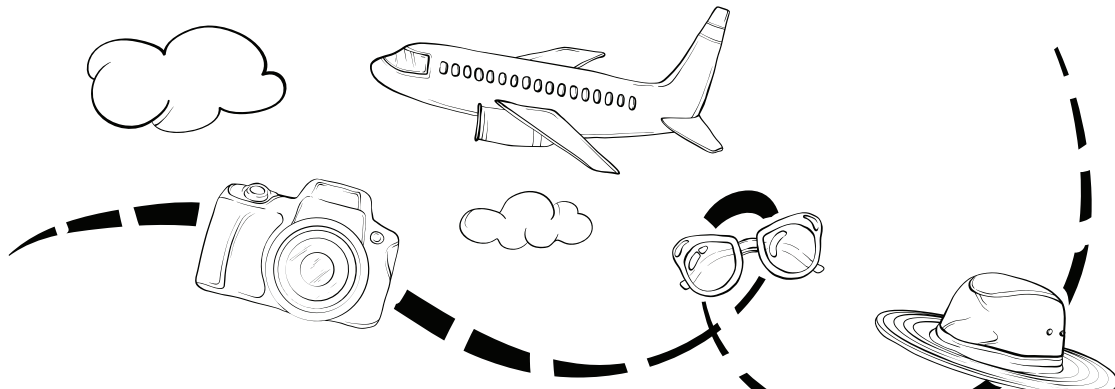

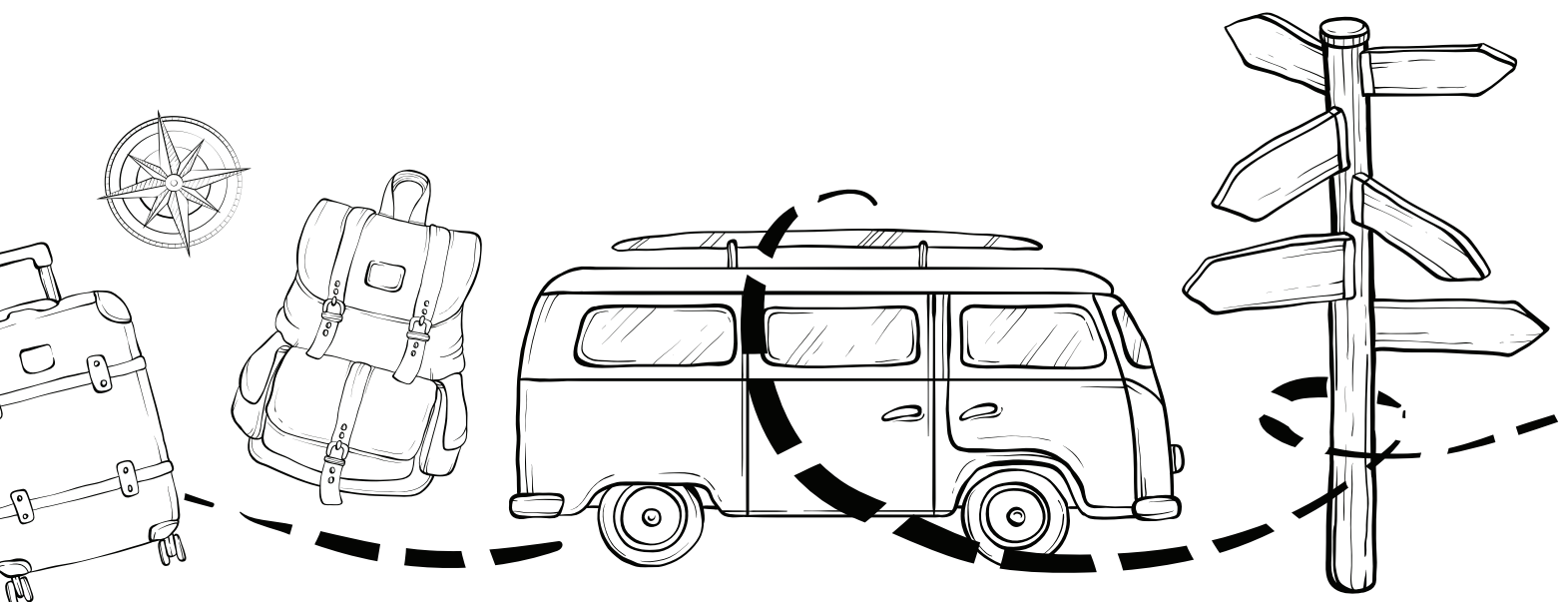
