You can also get French fries and pizza in Bavaria, so don't worry about finding something you'll like. Always be open to trying something new, though. You don't know until you try it, right?

The Schnitzel is our favorite! It's a yummy dish made from different types of meat. It's covered in breadcrumbs and then fried in butter. The most popular type of meat for schnitzel is veal (Wiener Schitzel) or pork (Schweineschnitzel). It can also be made with chicken (Hänchenschnitzel), or turkey (Putenschnitzel), too. Try some potato salad on the side!

Load the app to your phone before you travel!








